



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

GIFTINGHUMANITY

&

INTERNATIONAL EMERGENCY TEAM UK

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for collaboration of GIFTINGHUMANITY, Leicester, UK with the International Emergency Team UK (IETUK), has been signed on the 24th April 2018.

This MoU seeks to develop the mutual understanding and co-operation between the named organisations for the benefit of other overseas organisations or establishments who will benefit from the donation of medical supplies and equipment. This MoU does not extend to the supply of any form of medication or prescription drugs.

Whereas, the IETUK formed in 2013 with a mission to adopt the core values of the Fire and Rescue Service, which are: service to the community; people; diversity and improvement. Like-minded volunteer professionals from emergency services, medical and corporate backgrounds with varied skill sets constitute IETUK. Members are dedicated and hold a mutual desire to use their skills, knowledge and understanding to effect change and development of client organisations.

Whereas, GIFTINGHUMANITY is a non-profit charity and is run by charity representatives who volunteer their time to help humanity. Thus, the purpose is to make positive contributions to help the needy and, in turn, improve their lives.

Whereas, IETUK would like to collaborate with GIFTINGHUMANITY keeping in view the similarity of missions of both organisations and the challenges faced in ensuring the establishment of safer communities.

Therefore, IETUK shall periodically offer, on a collection basis, donated medical supplies and equipment in support of GIFTINGHUMANITIES agreed organisations to support their vision.

A defining condition of the MoU is that donated items will not be offered for sale by the receiving partner and will be solely for onward transfer to overseas organisations or establishments, free of charge.

This MoU shall take effect from the date of its signing by both parties. This MoU can be changed with mutual understanding and shall come to an end if any party fails to abide by the terms of this MoU.


This agreement is signed between the parties in Sunderland, United Kingdom.
